KEY HAZARD AND RISK CONTROLS – Safety, Environment and General

Safety

- Do not reach or stretch beyond capability
- Put mop and bucket away immediately after use.
- Make sure safety signs are used
- Do not walk over damp areas
- Leave surfaces as dry as possible

Environment

- Keep chemical use to a minimum
- Keep water use to minimum
- Waste solution to be disposed of in sewage (toilet of cleaners sink)

General

• Cloth and/or squeegee to be cleaned and dried after use

STEP BY STEP GUIDE

Pre-Operation

- Collect all equipment required from cleaner's storage area or cleaner's trolley
- Check condition of equipment for any damage or faults
- Review SDS for any chemicals to be used
- Apply all required PPE and make sure it is in good working condition
- Place safety signage at all access points to notify other persons of task

Instructions

- Do not leave mop lying on floor at any stage
- Spot cleaning of spillage's to be done as soon as possible after spillage has occurred.
- Most liquids will not stain if attended to before they dry. Mop up the bulk of the spillage.
- Chemical solution to be used in accordance with manufacturer's instructions or as directed by the Supervisor.
- Mop or wipe with cleaning solution, taking care not to spread soil any further
- Always work from the outside of soil or spillage towards the centre. Leave area as dry as possible.
- Spots and marks on fabrics should NOT be cleaned by above method but reported to Manager

Finishing Up

- Ensure all equipment is put away safely with mop head ideally off ground to allow to dry
- Only remove safety signage once floor surface is completely dry

EMERGENCY REQUIREMENTS

• Be aware of site emergency response provisions and first aid requirements

FINAL CHECK

- Are all work areas clean and tidy?
- Have you put all equipment and materials away neatly?
- Have you reported any near misses or incidents?
