KEY HAZARD AND RISK CONTROLS - Safety, Environment and General

Safety

- Use appropriate safety signage
- Wear appropriate PPE
- Do not pick up any sharps (syringes if found) Inform site supervisor and follow Sharps Collection and Disposal Safe Work Instruction

Environment

- Keep chemical use to a minimum
- Keep water use to a minimum
- Waste solution to be disposed of in sewage (toilet of cleaners sink)

General

Clean equipment and dry after use

STEP BY STEP GUIDE

Pre-Operation

- Collect all equipment required from cleaner's storage area or cleaner's trolley
- Check condition of equipment for any damage
- Review SDS for any chemicals to be used
- Apply all required PPE and make sure it is in good working condition
- Place safety signage at all access points to notify other persons of task, or communicate isolation of area

Instructions

- Check for hazards such as lights not working, floor coverings loose, handrails loose etc
- Accidents on stairs are a slip, trip and fall hazard. Ensure non-slip footwear is worn and keep working area clear of obstacles
- Commence at top of stair and work downwards
- Do landings first
- Work from outside edge to wall and then down to next step
- Use hand brush to remove dust and soil form edges of stairs
- Wipe banister rails, window ledges and spindles with damp sponge cloth
- If damp mopping is specified or required use a damp mop using as little water as possible
- Spot clean walls as required
- Dust behind radiators, top of skirting boards etc

Finishing Up

- Remove safety signage only after task is complete and area is safe to enter
- Remove all equipment and store neatly in cleaner's area

EMERGENCY REQUIREMENTS

Be aware of site emergency response provisions and first aid requirements

FINAL CHECK

- Are all work areas clean and tidy?
- Have you put all equipment and materials away neatly?
- Have you reported any near misses or incidents?
